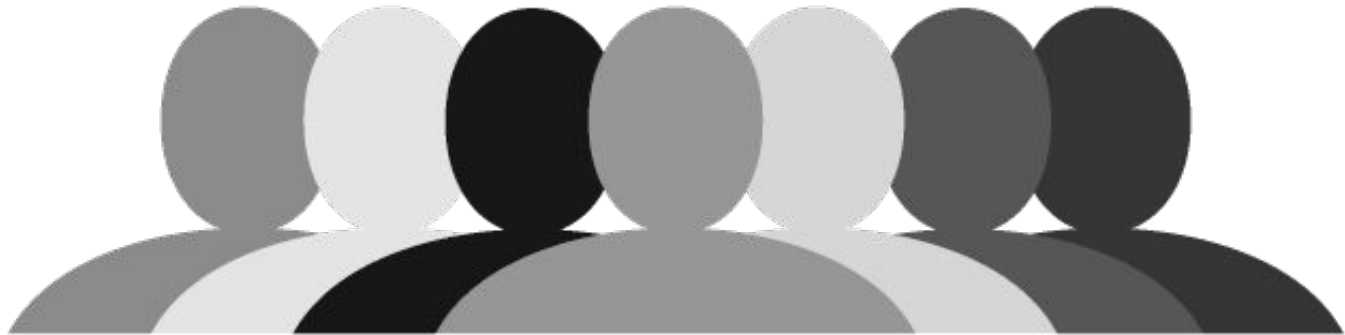

# Importance

- Pronouns (e.g., he/him) are part of gender identity
  - Gender is a spectrum
- Pronouns are independent of someone's name and/or appearance and can change over time
  - Assuming gender can be harmful and often reinforces a binary definition of gender

# Importance

- Using everyone's correct pronouns is vital for inclusivity
  - Ensures all gender identities are welcome and validated
  - Affirms the importance of trans and non-binary identities within your space
- Proactively sharing your pronouns encourages a respectful culture

# Action

- Include pronouns in your introductions
- Add your pronouns to your media profiles, online signatures, and physical identification
  - Google “How to add pronouns to \_\_\_”
- Use gender neutral language when pronouns are not explicitly stated

# Action

- Correct yourself if you use incorrect pronouns
  - In public and private settings
- Thank those who correct you
  - Avoid unproductive over-apologizing
- Politely correct the person speaking if they use incorrect pronouns for others
  - Reduces burden of correction on the individual whose pronouns were improperly stated
